~ Classic Amarone, very ripe cherry, wild berries followed by fresh and slightly spicy tones, beautiful finish

**Torres, 2013 Altos Ibericos Reserva, Tempranillo, Rioja** 88  
~ Black cherry with notes of black pepper and dried fig. Firm, velvety and fleshy

**C1 Joseph Drouhin, 2018 Côte de Beaune, Burgundy** 130  
~ Raspberry and tart cherry, concentrated body, approachable, balanced and juicy

**C0 Domaine Laroche, 2017 Chardonnay, Bourgogne** 60  
~ Delicate fruit, beautiful acidity and mineral final touch.

**D0 Pierre Sparr, 2018 Riesling, Alsace** 48  
~ Citrus fruits, wet stone and mineral. freshness and elegance dominate this bone-dry wine
